SECTION 1 – Contributions

SECTION 2 - Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities. You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches. (Do not pay any of this money now)

SECTION 3 - Items for Personal Use in the Educational Program

SECTION 4 - Voluntary Approved Funds P&C Contribution
